



## Grape Growing to Bottled Wine Conversion

### Grape Growing to Bottled Wine Conversion Chart

<u>UNIT</u>	<u>APPROXIMATE YIELD</u>
1 acre	= 1,200 vines (approximate Napa average)
1 acre	= 4 tons of grapes (approximate Napa average)
1 acre	= 600 gallons of wine
1 acre	= 10 French or American oak barrels
1 acre	= 250 cases of 750ml bottles of wine
1 acre	= 3,000 bottles at 750ml
1 acre	= 12,700 glasses of wine @ 6-ounce serving
1 ton	= 150 gallons of wine
1 ton	= 2.5 barrels of wine
1 ton	= 62.5 cases of 750ml bottles of wine
1 ton	= 750 bottles of 750ml
1 ton	= 3,175 glasses of wine @ 6-ounce serving
1 ton	= 1 bottle per day for 2 years and 20 days
1 barrel	= 60 gallons
1 barrel	= 25 cases of 750ml wine
1 barrel	= 300 bottles of 750ml wine
1 barrel	= 1,270 glasses of wine @ 6-ounce serving
1 vine	= 6.7 pounds of fruit
1 vine	= 63.6 ounces of wine (approx. 1/2 gallon)
1 vine	= 2.5 bottles of wine
1 vine	= 10.6 glasses of wine @ 6-ounce serving
1 gallon	= 0.42 cases of 750ml wine
1 gallon	= 5 bottles of 750ml wine
1 gallon	= 21.2 glasses of wine @ 6-ounce serving
1 bottle	= 2.7 pounds of fruit
1 bottle	= 25.4 ounces
1 bottle	= 4.2 glasses of wine @ 6-ounce serving
1 bottle	= 3 to 4 new best friends
1 glass	= 0.63 pounds of fruit @ 6-ounce serving
